DO RECYCLE THESE ITEMS:

Goes in Mixed Paper: Advertising Ads * Junk mail * Magazines
* Catalogs * Phone books/file folders * Printer paper * Calendars * Notepads

Newspaper: Only newspaper and phone books go together in same bin

Cardboard: Cereal boxes with the liner removed * Dry goods packaging
* Broken down boxes * Paper towel/toilet paper cores

Plastic bags/Paper Wrapping

DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLE BIN:

No brush or debris * No hazardous waste * No batteries * No styrofoam
* No paper towels * No tissue or toilet paper * No styrofoam packing peanuts
accepted* No food waste * No plastic coat hangers * NO PLASTIC that is not coded
#1 or #2 * NO plastic ornaments, unless plastic is coded with #1 or #2.

HOLIDAY RECYCLING TIPS:

- Buy wrapping paper from recyclable material or use the comics to wrap your gifts or even use a nice reusable cloth or material to wrap gift with a reusable bow.
- Look for greeting cards made out of recyclable material or reuse last years greeting cards instead.
- Make sure to recycle your cardboard and not the ribbons, that's not recyclable.
